OAN Overview and Vision

OpenAgriNetworks/OpenAgriNet (OAN) is a global coalition of innovators, governments, and organisations committed to transforming global agriculture. We leverage interoperable digital infrastructure networks, Artificial Intelligence (AI), and collaborative resource sharing to drive sustainable, efficient, and inclusive agricultural practices worldwide.

Our key objectives include:

- Establishing and stewarding the evolution of the network of practitioners and organisations.
- Designing, building, and establishing a global blueprint and architecture for OAN-based Digital Agriculture Grids.
- Addressing the livelihood needs of core beneficiary classes (e.g., rural smallholder farmers and their families) in an equitable and gender-inclusive way.
- Building and curating Digital Public Goods (DPGs) to facilitate the adaptation of the OAN blueprint and architecture frameworks in several country implementations of the Grids.
- Driving adoption of OAN globally.
- Designing, curating, and disseminating best practices in Digital Agriculture

Working Groups

3. Policy & Partnerships Working Group: This group would focus on policy advocacy, partnership building, and community engagement. It would involve individuals from organisations focused on policy, funding, and outreach.
